BOARD REQUIREMENTS REGARDING THE ACCESSIBILITY, USE AND MAINTENANCE OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS (AEDs)

Prevention of a sports-related concussions and head injuries is an important component of Monroe Township Public School’s athletic program as addressed in Board Policy and Regulation 2431.4, Prevention and Treatment of Sports-Related Concussions and Head Injuries (attached). Further, the Board recognizes that the use of automated external defibrillators (AEDs) within the first minutes of cardiac arrest increases the victim’s chances of survival.

As an organization that uses district facilities for youth sports, you are responsible for assuring the Monroe Township Board of Education (“Board”) that your coaches and other volunteers have been properly trained to know the facts about concussion and head injury and when it is safe for athletes to return to play.

Further, you are responsible for assuring the Board that your organization will comply with the requirements regarding the accessibility, use and maintenance of AEDs as set forth in Board Policy and Regulation 7510, Use of School Facilities (attached).

This statement of Compliance must be presented to the Board along with a current Certificate of Insurance naming the Board as an additional insured prior to the use of our facilities.
