As a student attending Monroe Township High School, you have been issued an iPad. By signing this agreement (can be done by parent or guardian), you understand that this iPad remains the property of Monroe Township Board of Education, and you are agreeing to return the iPad at the end of the school year or upon no longer attending Monroe Township High School.

COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH IPAD

This school year, with the refresh of new devices, the board of education has approved a restructuring of the iPad payment fees. A payment of \$30.00 per device may be paid in person on the iPad deployment date. Checks should be made out to the MTBOE (Monroe Township Board of Education), money orders or cash will also be accepted. The fee may also be paid prior to the deployment date by using your MYSCHOOLBUCKS account. There is an additional convenience fee for this alternative.

Each device is insured for two-crack screens per year, per device. Insurance does not cover loss, irreparable damage, or theft of the iPad or provided accessories. The following is a list of accessories and their value if lost or damaged.

20 Watt USB-C iPad Charger with Cable: \$39.99

Third accidental cracked screen in one school year: \$255.95 (included \$6.95 shipping)

Logitech Rugged Combo 3 Case: \$99.95

Lost or stolen iPad: \$394.00

If these exact items are lost, stolen, or not returned upon graduation or disenrollment from MTHS, the student will be responsible to reimburse the district at full cost.

ANTI-BIG BROTHER ACT

In accordance with New Jersey Statutes Annotated (N.J.S.A) 18A:36-39 (P.L. 2013, c.44), the Anti-Big Brother Act was enacted. It requires that parents/guardians of students, who have been assigned district or school owned electronic devices for use outside of school in connection with the district's academic program, must be notified of the following:

If a school district furnishes a student with a laptop computer, cellular telephone, or other electronic device, the district shall provide the student with written or electronic notification that the electronic device may record or collect information on the student's activity or the student's use of the device if the electronic device is equipped with a camera, global positioning system, or

other feature capable of recording or collecting information on the student's activity or use of the device.

Furthermore, the school district shall not use any of the capabilities in a manner that would violate the privacy rights of the student or any individual residing with the student.
