

The Monroe Township School District proudly services over 100 English Language Learners speaking more than 15 different languages. Students are identified via the Home Language Survey, records review and language screening. Once identified for ESL services, students are supported in their classes by dedicated staff members who work to ensure students receive comprehensible input in order to engage meaningfully in all learning experiences.

In the spring, ELLs take the WIDA ACCESS for ELLs 2.0. This assessment is completed on a computer or iPad and has sections for each language domain: reading, writing, speaking and listening. In order to be exited from ESL, students must earn a 4.5 (or higher) overall score as well as achievement in their other classes. Students are monitored for two years after exiting from ESL to ensure they are receiving the support needed to succeed.
