## Woodland School Re-opening

### Frequently Asked Questions

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#### **1. What will my child's day look like?**

##### a. Hybrid Students

- i. Hybrid students will be split into Gold and Purple cohorts based on last name and will attend school 2-3 days per week. While in school, students will receive in-person instruction. On the days they are not in school, they will join their class virtually and complete synchronous, semi-synchronous, and asynchronous assignments.

##### b. Fully Remote Students

- i. Fully remote students will join their class virtually and complete synchronous, semi-synchronous, and asynchronous assignments. This will look different than our current remote learning environment as teachers will be working with hybrid and fully remote students at the same time.

#### **2. What is synchronous instruction?**

- a. Synchronous instruction means that a teacher will be providing instruction to students who are both in person and remote. Students who are remote (fully remote or hybrid remote) will be signing into their classroom link during school hours for daily instruction, 5 days per week.

#### **3. Will my child's teacher change based on my hybrid/full remote response?**

- a. Synchronous instruction allows your child's teacher to instruct the students in class and at home at the same time. This will limit classroom teacher

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changes. In the event that a classroom change is needed, you will be contacted by building administration.

**4. What are the learning hours of instruction?**

- a. For grades 1-5, instructional hours will follow the four hour session schedule with the additional hour in the afternoon.
  - i. Woodland hours: 8:06 AM - 12:10 PM
  - ii. Afternoon hour 1:30 - 2:30 PM - as needed and assigned by the teacher

**5. Is my hybrid/full remote choice for the full year?**

- a. We are asking parents to commit to a full marking period/trimester when making the choice. This will assist us in ensuring scheduling and staff for all students. Yes, you will be able to change your mind but there will be a period of time that it will take to make that change. We are using the information about parents who may want all virtual to create our staff needs. Any changes between the two programs may require a teacher change.

**6. If you opt out of transportation, are you doing so for the entire year or are you dividing the year into increments for parental decision making?**

- a. We are asking for parents to make a decision that will at least last a marking period.

**7. Does the transportation waiver mean that the parent is committing to drive our children to school until January 2021 OR for the full 2020-2021 school year?**

- a. The transportation waiver is for the duration of the remote instruction. If changes are necessary, written notice to the building principal

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should be made no later than 2 weeks prior to the end of the marking period.

**8. Is there Falcon Care?**

- a. Yes, Falcon Care is available for hybrid students. Please contact Sharon Jensen and refer to the Falcon Care website from the district website for more information.
- b. The ECE Program **is not** being run at this time.
