- Students provide their own transportation to PU during the summer.
- US Citizen, Legal Permanent resident or international students attending HS in the US
- Applications filed between Feb 1 and March 15 (deadline).
- Decisions: May 31, 2017
- Students apply online to complete a Princeton Learning Program application. Completed applications are due to the Office of the Dean for Research postmarked by 3/15. Students/families are responsible for generating, mailing their application.
