What is MTSEPAG?

Special Education Parent Advisory Groups are required for all school districts in New Jersey. The purpose of these groups is to provide opportunities for parents and community members to offer input to their districts on critical issues relating to students with disabilities. These are parent led groups.

The Purpose of the MTSEPAG:

- To provide direct input on the policies, programs and practices that impact services and supports for children with disabilities and their families.
- To increase the involvement of families of children with special needs in making recommendations on special education policy.
- To advise on matters that pertain to the education, health and safety of children with special needs.
 - To advise on unmet needs of children with disabilities.
- The MTSEPAG meetings are not intended to be a “support group” or a “gripe session”.

Who should join and come to our meetings?

- Every parent and guardian of a classified student, Pre-K through 21 who resides in Monroe Township
 - Parents and guardians of students who have 504 plans
- Parents and guardians of students who are being evaluated or are suspected of having a disability.
 - Parents and guardians of students in out of district placements
- Any parent/guardian of a student in the Monroe Township Public schools or community member who is interested in offering input on the critical issues relating to the education of students with disabilities
