On Thursday, Governor Murphy stated that all schools will remain closed. He will revisit this decision on April 17th. School districts do not have the authority to change this decision. Therefore, remote learning in Monroe Township Schools will continue at least through April 17th. **Spring Break will be a true break.** During the week of April 6-13, please do just that. Relax. There will be no remote learning during this time.

State Testing

Governor Murphy has stated this week that NJ has requested a waiver from the federal government to not administer NJSLA (state assessments) this school year.
