Dear Parents/Guardians:

Please be advised that the high school administration and school security have identified a number of situations during the AM student drop-off period that are causing significant traffic and safety hazards along and within the Schoolhouse Road and high school entrances. Just to remind all of us that all entrances have been labeled, marked with signs, and designated as specific entrances for students, teachers or student drop-off. **No students are to be dropped off across the street at the tennis courts or stadium parking lot.**

- The **NORTH Entrance** (the only entrance on Perrineville Road) is designated as a **bus entrance, student parking entrance, and for visitors only**. Cars entering the North Entrance may not turn left into the parking lot, nor can they turn left out of the parking lot.
- The **WEST Entrance** (the entrance on Schoolhouse Road closest to the traffic light) is designated as a **student, staff and visitor parking entrance only**. **Please do not use this entrance to drop off students in a parking lot.**
- The **EAST Entrance** (the other entrance on Schoolhouse Road furthest from the traffic light) is designated as **staff entrance, school bus entrance and student drop-off**.
- **IN ADDITION, the lane directly in front of the high school is a one way moving east to west and used for student drop off and faculty parking only! No cars, except for those dropping off their children should be travelling on this one way lane. Seniors who use this lane to travel to their parking spots will risk losing their parking privileges. Please remember staff have designated parking spots. Parents should be aware of these spots to avoid congestion in the student drop off lane.**
- The speed limit on campus is 5 miles per hour.
- All drivers **MUST** stop for pedestrians in the crosswalks.
- **All parents are encouraged to have their child ride the district provided school bus.**

The school administration is asking for your cooperation in using the correct entrance and guidelines when arriving on campus. Safety in the parking lot is an important issue; we are hoping that with your help we can increase the safety of pedestrians in the crosswalks and parking lots.
