ELIGIBILTY

NJSIAA Eligibility Policy

- All Fall Sophomore-Senior Athletes must have earned a minimum of 30 credits from their previous year to be eligible for participation
- All Freshmen are eligible for the Fall & Winter Seasons!

- Spring
 - All Student-athletes must earn at least 15 credits to be eligible for the Spring Season


