APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Mr. Tufano and seconded by Ms. Bierman to approve the minutes for the Public Board of Education Meeting, November 17, 2021. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Tufano and seconded by Mr. Paluri to approve the minutes for the Closed Session Meeting, November 17, 2021. Motion carried.

STUDENT BOARD MEMBERS' REPORT

Ms. Jain reported the following:

Brookside School – 4th Grade students participated in a Colonial Carousel Day. Teachers and students dressed as colonist and traveled throughout the 4th Grade classrooms to learn about the games; traits; and clothing of that time period. 3rd Grade students participated in a Thanksgiving Carousel Day Activity, where they learned about the history of Thanksgiving. In Media, students created positive messages of gratitude and thanks for friends, family members, teachers and staff members and were on a “Thankful Wall” across from the Media Center. Brookside’s Student Council and staff members will be collecting food, clothing and gifts for families in need as the holidays approach.

Middle School - The first Career Café was held this month and will continue monthly covering different career paths based on students interest. The 6th Grade Band Concert was held on December 14th. The Middle School will be participating in Spirit Week December 13th through December 17th.

High School - MTHS Chorus Concert is being held this evening. MTHS Math Honor Society will be hosting a fundraiser at Bovine Burgers in Jamesburg next Wednesday. MTHS Robotics Club is hosting a Krispy Crème fundraiser until December 22nd. MTHS DECA and FBLA testing took place this week for January competitions.

Mr. Lattupally reported the following:

Barclay Brook School – Students participated in the Hour of Code, a global event to promote computer science awareness.

Oak Tree School – November ended with a very successful food drive. Staff and students are currently conducting a holiday gift drive. Students are also participating in the Hour of Code; the Ten Days of Oak Tree; Flannel Day; Ugly Holiday Outfit Day; and Cozy Holiday Sock Day. The Holiday Door Decoration Contest and Falcon Leadership winners will be announced shortly.

Applegarth School - Received a wonderful response to the gift drive this year. A Pajama Day fundraiser was held, and they raised over \$370 for the gift drive. The live Band and Chorus Concert was held yesterday. The Principal Book Club met yesterday as well.

Mill Lake School - Held a Think Pink fundraiser, which raised \$1,102.00 for breast cancer research. A food drive was held in November. Students participated in Grateful Falcon, where they created feathers for things that they were thankful for and created a giant Mill Lake Turkey displayed at the school.

PRESENTATION OF PLAQUES TO BOARD MEMBERS ANDY PALURI, RUPA SIEGEL AND PETER TUFANO

Ms. Arminio, Ms. Chanley, Mr. Gorski and Dr. Layman thanked Mr. Paluri, Ms. Siegel and Mr. Tufano for their service to the board of education, the community and students in the district and presented each with a plaque of appreciation.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Ms. Chrissy Skurbe, Chairperson of the Policy Committee, reported that the policy committee met and had a discussion regarding some possible revisions for the HIB policy. The discussion will be carried over to the next meeting. The committee discussed the policies on tonight’s

agenda for second read as well as a few mandated policies from Strauss Esmay submitted for approval as a first read tonight.

Ms. Chrissy Skurbe, Chairperson of the Community Engagement & Communication Committee, reported the committee discussed the advertising program and reported that they are almost ready to go with the advertisement. Ms. Skurbe stated that the committee would like to move forward with the inner fence project first and it will be broken down into three projects to keep within the bid threshold. Ms. Skurbe reported that the committee will be sending out the communication survey, Ms. Arminio will ask the Township to send it out as well. The committee will discuss the results at the February meeting and discuss where changes can be made to increase better communication throughout the district. Lastly, Ms. Skurbe reported that the committee discussed inviting the legislators to attend a meeting. Ms. Arminio added that the committee selected two tentative dates, February 9th and February 23rd, one of which will be scheduled as a special meeting, allowing the public to attend. The topics to be covered will be fair funding and impact fees.

Mr. Peter Tufano, Chairperson of the Buildings, Grounds & Transportation Committee, stated that the committee met and discussed the following:

SSP Architects presented a PowerPoint presentation of their results and findings in the Facilities Assessment Report for Applegarth School. The committee discussed options of renewing and adding to the school versus constructing an entirely new school and will further this discussion with the full board.

Administration presented demographic study proposals from three professionals that were previously submitted at the July 2020/2021 BG&T Committee Meeting. The committee is recommending proceeding with Ross Haber Associates and will present this recommendation at the upcoming board meeting.

Cindy Sue Schaller, Food Service Director, provided an overview of three grants that she recommends pursuing for new food service equipment at the schools. The committee was supportive of her efforts and authorized proceeding. Cindy also gave a review of the equipment and software upgrade needs and the committee indicated that they would support this endeavor. Mr. Gorski confirmed that the cafeteria fund could be utilized to pay for this equipment.

Lastly, Mr. Tufano reported that the Board President had directed Ms. Chanley and Administration to contact township officials for information and documentation pertaining to the landfill near Woodland School. The township directed administration to two special web links, one at the township and one at NJDEP which contained all related test reports, correspondence etc. pertaining to this matter. The committee requested that Ms. Chanley and Mr. Tague personally walk the school grounds to see if we can locate or identify any hazardous waste containers or similar items of concern and report out as appropriate.

Ms. Siegel inquired why the committee felt Ross Haber Associates was the better option to go with for the demographic study. Mr. Tufano responded Ross Haber Associates' proposal had the

fastest results and the lowest price and the committee was assured by Mr. Gorski and Ms. Chanley that they will oversee the process and catch any errors that may be made.

Ms. Skurbe added that Ross Haber Associates has experience with working with township officials and are most familiar with them. Ms. Skurbe added that administration and the facilities director were asked if there were any concerns with any of the demographers that submitted proposals and no concerns were noted.

Mr. Gorski reported that the proposal from Ross Haber Associates indicated an enrollment projection fee of \$4,500; GIS Mapping for \$2,500; and an attendance zone fee for \$3,500. Mr. Gorski inquired if the Board would like to have the attendance zone included. Mr. Paluri reported that the Township would have one and it would be redundant for the district to include it. Mr. Tufano stated that the bg&t committee can get into the details of the proposal at their next meeting.

A motion was made by Mr. Tufano and seconded by Ms. Bierman that the members of the Monroe Township Board of Education approve the following resolution by consent roll call:

It is recommended that the members of the Monroe Township Board of Education authorize and approve the firm of Ross Haber Associates to provide a Demographic Study for the Monroe Township Board of Education based on ASSA enrollment information from October 15, 2021 at the fee delineated in the proposal, enrollment projections \$4,500, and GIS Mapping \$2,500. Should the GIS be provided by the Township, the District will pass on the GIS Mapping option. The District chooses to forego the attendance zone listed in the proposal for a fee of \$3,500.

Ms. Arminio asked Mr. Tufano to amend the resolution to include a review of the Affordable Housing build out and considering the estimated 4,379 units under Monroe's Affordable Housing obligation. Mr. Tufano agreed to Ms. Arminio's friendly amendment. Ms. Belko inquired if that would delay the report in any way. Ms. Arminio withdrew her request for the amendment after Mr. Gorski explained that the Board will review the report in draft form and include that information.

Ms. Bierman stated that there has been a public outcry regarding the utilization of Ross Haber Associates based on prior experiences and stated that the residents should have an opportunity to provide their thoughts.

A motion was made by Ms. Bierman and seconded by Ms. Belko to table the motion to approve the firm of Ross Haber Associates to provide a Demographic Study until the Board has had an opportunity to hear public comments. Roll call 8-0-0-0-2. Motion carried.

Ms. Kathleen Belko, Chairperson of the Curriculum Committee, reported that the committee met and reviewed curriculum for Art Fundamentals, which was previously known as Unified Visual Arts. The class will be an elective for all students and include a complete inclusive environment.

Next, the committee was presented with the three-year Bilingual ESL Plan.

Lastly, Ms. Belko reported that the committee received a presentation on the different Career Academies at the High School.

Ms. Karen Bierman, Vice Chairperson of the Finance Committee, reported that the committee met and reviewed the following:

The committee was provided with the monthly attorney invoice for review.

Regarding the Jamesburg Tuition Liability Discussion, the committee was informed that all of the State forms required to calculate the actual June 30, 2021 Per Pupil Cost by grade level were in process and should be completed by next month's finance committee meeting. Mr. Gorski informed the members that these reports will generate an actual total tuition charge for Jamesburg for the year ended 06/30/21. Ms. Bierman reported that administration will compare the actual total charge to the amount paid through the Budget and the expected over payment will be applied towards the tuition indebtedness.

Mr. Gorski provided a 22/23 Budget update. The next step is to consolidate the budgets from all eight schools, technology and special education into a format following the NJ DOE Chart of Accounts.

June 30, 2021 Audit Update - Mr. Gorski informed the committee members that he spoke with Kimberly Kelly, CPA of HFA, to determine the anticipated release date of State figures required under GASB 75 for Post Employment Health and Pension Benefits. Ms. Kelly indicated that the figures were expected in late December or early January and that HFA will need two weeks to incorporate the figures into foot notes and go through the firms quality review. The audit deadline is February 5, 2022.

Mr. Gorski announced a NJSDA and NJDOE \$75,000,000 grant for emergent and capital maintenance needs. Mr. Gorski indicated that Monroe's share of this grant is \$166,924.00 and that the district will identify an appropriate project to use this grant money towards soon.

Mr. Gorski updated the committee on the ARP ESSER Grant and indicated that the following amounts have been awarded:

ESSER in the amount of \$1,036,389

Accelerated Learning Coaching and Educator Support Grant in the amount \$550,524

Evidence-Based Summer Learning and Enrichment Activities Grant in the amount \$40,000

Evidence-Based Comprehensive Beyond the School Day Activities Grant in the amount \$40,000

NJTSS Mental Health Support Staffing Grant in the amount \$45,000

Dr. Layman discussed the proposed utilization for compensatory services and/or facility needs.

Mr. Gorski gave credit to Ms. Arminio for negotiating a Shared Service Agreement for the restoration and upgrade of the stadium track and turf field with Mayor Dalina.

Mr. Gorski indicated that it is a 1.7-million-dollar upgrade to be paid by the Township. Mr. Gorski indicated that he and Mr. Tague worked with the architects and board attorney to formally develop the Agreement and the next steps are as follows:

- December 8, 2021: Advertise for Bid
- December 16, 2021: Pre-Bid Conference
- January 19, 2022: Bid opening

Ms. Arminio thanked all the committee chairs and members for their time and effort participating in the committees last year. Ms. Arminio reminded the community that the current Board has instituted live-streaming and recording of committee meetings for public view for transparency purposes, even though it is not required. Adding that sometimes during those open meetings information has been misconstrued, but the Board has deemed it important for the public to have access to it before it is presented to the full Board.

Mr. Adi Nikitinsky, Chairperson of the Personnel Committee, reported that the committee met and reviewed the Vacancy List, Exit Survey, and Sidebar Agreement that is listed on the agenda for approval this evening.

PUBLIC FORUM

Prakash Parab 33 Dayna Drive – thanked the outgoing board members for their dedicated service and congratulated Ms. Chanley on her appointed position of Acting Superintendent. Regarding enrollment numbers, Mr. Parab stated that the Applegarth School is at 180% capacity and Oak Tree School is at 163% capacity. Mr. Parab requested that the Board act quickly with the Applegarth expansion. Mr. Parab also requested that the Board look at the expansions needed at the High School, Middle School and Applegarth so the referendum will be ready for January. Lastly, Mr. Parab encouraged 7th & 8th Grade parents to view the STEM presentation on the website, so they are prepared for 9th Grade.

Jill DeMaio 48 Linwood Drive and Steve Riback 23 Riviera Drive – thanked Ms. Siegel and Mr. Paluri for their years of service to the district.

Brian Fabiano 19 Patricia Place – congratulated Ms. Chanley on her appointment of Acting Superintendent. Mr. Fabiano thanked and commended Mr. Tufano, who continued to attend meetings after he was repeatedly attacked by members of the community. Mr. Fabiano stated that he hopes that Ms. Siegel takes the concerns from the board of education with her to the town council. Considering Mr. Paluri affiliation with the county executive superintendent, Mr. Fabiano stated that he was surprised that he didn't recuse himself from the vote of the Acting Superintendent of Schools. Regarding the donation of furniture on the agenda, Mr. Fabiano inquired about the district's liability of receiving such. Next, Mr. Fabiano inquired about the number of times the District used Ross Haber Associates and any concerns they had with them.

Tim Eosso 2 Allison Court - congratulated Ms. Chanley on her appointment. Mr. Eosso congratulated the three outgoing members, adding that Mr. Tufano always did the right thing, and his intentions were not about politics. Next, Mr. Eosso congratulated the incoming board members adding that they will bring complete transparency and do what is best for our children. Mr. Eosso added that parents will no longer need to worry about a particular board member demanding special favors for her children.

Michael Olesky 50 Mayberry Avenue – requested that the Board consider a few issues with the selection of the proposals for the demographic study such as: what the price includes; thoroughness of report; SSP Architects recommendation; is the final product is the same; and who is actually going to do the work.

Mr. Gorski provided the details of the fees from the submitted proposals that were presented to the bg&t committee. Ms. Arminio added that the committee also considered the timeframe presented from each company.

Mike Weinert 9 Sequoia Court – requested that the Board consider allowing remote participation for the public meetings. Mr. Weinert spoke of alleged past behavior of Mr. Tufano.

Sarah Aziz 3 Launcelot Drive – thanked Mr. Paluri and Ms. Siegel for their service, hard work, and good judgement to the board of education. Ms. Aziz acknowledge that Ms. Siegel is the first South Asian American to be elected to serve on the Town Council.

Doug Poye 4 Tamarack Road – inquired about the details of the ESSER Grant. Mr. Poye stated that sometimes during committee reports a motion is made and voted upon prior to the public having any notification that the Board will be voting on it nor had an opportunity to question or voice any concern related to it. Mr. Poye suggested that committee recommendations that are being made to the full Board be part of the board meeting agenda.

Pradeep Melam 4 Jake Place – thanked Ms. Siegel, Mr. Paluri and Mr. Tufano for their service to the district. Mr. Melam inquired if the business office utilizes financial software and questioned why it takes a month to calculate per pupil costs. Mr. Melam stated that the cafeteria fund is not listed in last year's Comprehensive Annual Report. Next, Mr. Melam inquired what the names of the applications/documents are that are sent to the County and State utilizing the data from October 15th. Next, Mr. Melam questioned the calculation and reporting of transportation costs for Jamesburg students. Lastly, Mr. Melam inquired about the finances of the turf field replacement agreement with the Township.

Roll call for the motion approving the demographic study proposal from Ross Haber Associates. Roll call 8-0-0-2 motion carried.

ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

Dr. Layman reported that the MTHS Choral Concert is being held this evening; the Middle School and several elementary concerts were held earlier this week.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT **PERSONNEL**

A motion was made by Mr. Tufano and seconded by Ms. Skurbe that Personnel Items A – AQ be approved by consent roll call. Roll Call 8-0-0-0-2. Motion Carried. The vote included the Jamesburg Board Member Representative where appropriate. A copy of the Superintendent's Personnel Report is attached to the official set of minutes.

BOARD ACTION

A motion was made by Mr. Tufano and seconded by Ms. Bierman that Board Action Items A-K be approved by consent roll call. Roll call 8-0-0-0-2. Motion carried. The vote included the Jamesburg Representative where appropriate. A copy of the Board Action section of the Superintendent's Report is attached to the official set of minutes.

Sadly, Ms. Skurbe reported that Mr. John Leary, a former board member, who served the board of education from 2003-2011 passed away Sunday night. On behalf of the Board Ms. Skurbe extended sincere condolences to Mr. Leary's family.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT/RECOMMENDATIONS

A motion was made by Mr. Tufano and seconded by Mr. Nikitinsky that Board Action Items A-L with the exception of Item J, which Mr. Gorski removed from his report, be approved by consent roll call.

Ms. Belko inquired if Item H/ the upgraded P.O.S Terminal equipment and related software is in the 21/22 Budget. Mr. Gorski responded no and explained that the cafeteria fund is not part of the general fund school Budget. Ms. Belko inquired about the amount in the cafeteria fund. Due to Mr. Gorski not having the balance on hand, Ms. Belko requested tabling the item until the Board was appraised of the amount.

A motion was made by Ms. Belko and seconded by Ms. Skurbe to table Item H until the Board has the knowledge of the available funds in the cafeteria funds. Roll Call 5-3-0-0-2. Motion carried with Ms. Siegel, Mr. Paluri and Mr. Tufano voting no.

Ms. Arminio asked for clarification on Item G/ Equipment Assistance Grant-Competitive Grant, asking if the grant is not received will the District purchase the coolers. Mr. Gorski responded no.

Roll call on Items A-L with the exception of Items H & J 8-0-0-0-2. Motion carried with Mr. Paluri abstaining on Item I. The vote included the Jamesburg Representative where appropriate. A copy of the Board Action section of the Business Administrator's Report is attached to the official set of minutes.

BOARD PRESIDENT REPORT

Ms. Arminio thanked the students involved with the food and monetary collection that Dr. Parab coordinated. Ms. Arminio added that she very proud of all the students in the community for their efforts in the many community volunteer programs this year. Ms. Arminio wished all a happy and safe break.

OTHER BOARD OF EDUCATION BUSINESS

A motion was made by Mr. Tufano and seconded by Ms. Skurbe that in the event that any board member or administrator meets to discuss any official district business with any other elected official in the Township or State that a written report is provided as a means to update the Board. In the event there is any discussion that results in action to be taken by the Board or decision to be made that directly impacts the District, the board member is required to bring such decision to the Board as a whole before a vote. If such action is not done the board member will be in violation of policy and subject to an ethics complaint or any other reprimand that the Board sees fit.

Mr. Gagliardi clarified that if Mr. Tufano's motion passes and a board member violates the policy, it would be a violation of board policy. It would not be a violation of the School Ethics Act.

3-5-0-0-2 motion failed with Ms. Arminio, Mr. Belko, Mr. Nikitinsky, Mr. Paluri, and Ms. Siegel voting no.

Mr. Paluri reported that the IFM organization offers volunteer hours for students in the community and encouraged all to get involved.

Ms. Belko reported that she recently attended the Falcon Pals Winter Fest and painting night sponsored by the National Honors Art Society, adding that both were wonderful events that both the students and parents enjoyed.

PUBLIC FORUM

Betty Saborido 2 Barrymore Drive – on behalf of SEPAG, Ms. Saborido thanked the members of board of education for their voluntary service. Ms. Saborido thanked Dr. Layman for working closely with SEPAG to address systemic issues in special education. While collaborating with SEPAG, Mr. Flaum; Mr. Morolda; and Dr. Roselle Dr. Layman has been working diligently to move special education in the right direction. Ms. Saborido commended them for working with and supporting Ms. Chanley to ensure the work that they have been doing continues smoothly.

Prakash Parab 33 Dayna Drive – stated that the district needs to get more funding from the State for special education. Mr. Parab thanked those students involved with the food donation that donated to over 400 families in the township. Mr. Parab inquired what the next step is for the Applegarth School expansion. Next, Mr. Parab spoke about a student threat in Manalapan and inquired about the district's policy on threats and school safety.

Pradeep Melam 4 Jake Place – regarding communication to parents, Mr. Melam inquired if the district has the capability to send text messages to parents. Mr. Melam thanked the curriculum committee for the discussion on extending the languages in the ESL curriculum. Mr. Melam spoke of the pilot program mentioned in the mailer Mayor Dalina sent out regarding funding construction projects in lieu of taxes and requested that Ms. Siegel support the program when she's appointed to the council.

Mike Weinert 9 Sequoia Court –shared some of his concerns with the ECE and Falcon Care programs mentioning staffing issues, staff compensation, communication problems and lack of funds put into the programs.

Sarah Shama 15 Edward Avenue – spoke about the divisiveness regarding the Board and expressed concerns how that filters to staff and student mental health. Ms. Shama requested that the Board look into students being denied opportunities due to non-compliance of items from adults. Next, Ms. Shama spoke about the district's Covid-19 protocols.

Rosemary Carolyn 3 Walter Way – spoke of her knowledge and experiences with obtaining and the worth of a doctrine in education degree and recommended that the Board do a more extensive search for the permanent superintendent position.

Tim Eosso 2 Allison Court – disagreed with the previous speaker and stated that Ms. Chanley has come up through the ranks and has proven that she is capable to do the job. Mr. Eosso spoke of builder impact fees and implored the Board to put pressure on the Mayor and Council to support them. Mr. Eosso inquired if a builder can donate money to the school district. Lastly, regarding comments made by a prior speaker after leaving the podium, Mr. Eosso stated that no member of the Board should be threatened by a member of the public.

Michael Olesky 50 Mayberry Avenue – stated that he would pass along information of a legislator supporting build impact fees to the Board. Mr. Olesky requested that Ms. Chanley's comment where things are headed with the referendum.

Tracy Hart 110 Avenue K – inquired about excused absences for extracurricular activities and if board members are involved in making that decision. Next, Ms. Hart spoke of the process of hiring the acting superintendent. Ms. Hart stated that the Board is doing a disservice to the district by appointing Ms. Chanley and board members should not have any alternative motives while serving on the Board.

Doug Poye 4 Tamarack Road – referring to the NJ Administrative Code regarding acting administrators and required certificates, Mr. Poye expressed concerns regarding the process that the Board used for appointing the Acting Superintendent of Schools. Next, Mr. Poye stated that to his knowledge, Ms. Chanley was appointed at a salary higher than any previous superintendent in Monroe.

Speaking from his thirty years of experience with school law, Mr. Gagliardi stated that the process that the Board followed for the appointment of the Acting Superintendent has been followed dozens of times. Mr. Gagliardi stated that there was nothing unusual about the process and then explained how it was followed.

Brian Fabiano 19 Patricia Place – spoke of the divisiveness that he believes past board presidents have created regarding the appointment of the Acting Superintendent. Mr. Fabiano stated that he spoke with the County Superintendent and State Commissioner's Office, and both confirmed the process was followed properly. Mr. Fabiano questioned what the surplus in the budget is and inquired if any of those funds could have been used for the turf fields. Mr. Fabiano also inquired

about the bond and how much the 1.7 will end up costing and why there wasn't any transparency with the Agreement. Next, Mr. Fabiano inquired if there are any updates with the traffic pattern at the High School. Then, Mr. Fabiano inquired if the district is considering changes to the quarantine protocol for siblings. Mr. Fabiano also inquired about the Falcon Care/ECE leadership vacancies. Lastly, Mr. Fabiano asked what the current quarantine numbers were.

Sarah Aziz 3 Launcelot Drive – thanked Mr. Paluri for shedding some light on the selection process for the superintendent last month. Ms. Aziz expressed disappointment that the Board appointed an Acting Superintendent who lacked the recommendation of the County Superintendent and didn't have the required certificate or central office experience.

NOTES

Note 1: Any member of the public may record the proceedings of a public meeting of the Board in a manner that does not interrupt the proceedings, inhibit the conduct of the meeting, or distract Board Members or other observers present at the meeting.

The Board will permit the use of tape recorders, still or movie cameras, or videotape cameras only when notice of such intended use has been given to the Board Secretary one day in advance of the meeting. Any video recording device must be located and operated from inconspicuous locations in the meeting room as determined by the presiding officer of the meeting. The presiding officer may also limit the number of video recording devices if he/she determines the number and position of the video recording devices will be an unnecessary intrusion to the meeting. In this event, preference will be given based on the order in which prior notice requesting to record the meeting was provided to the Board Secretary.

The presiding officer shall determine when any recording device interferes with the conduct of a Board meeting and may order that an interfering device be removed.

Note 2: The Jamesburg Representative shall be eligible to vote on only those matters specifically designated in N.J.S.A 18A:38-8.1, as follows:

- (1) Tuition to be charged the sending district by the receiving district and the bill lists or contracts for the purchase, operation or maintenance of facilities, equipment and instructional materials to be used in the education of the pupils of the sending district.
- (2) New capital construction to be utilized by sending district pupils.
- (3) Appointment, transfer or removal of teaching staff members providing services to pupils of the sending district, including any teaching staff member who is a member of the receiving district's central administrative staff.
- (4) Addition or deletion of curricular and extracurricular programs involving pupils of the sending district.
- (5) Any matter directly involving sending district students or programs and services used by them.
- (6) The annual receiving district budget.
- (7) Any collectively-negotiated agreement involving employees who provide services used by sending district students.
- (8) Any individual employee contracts not covered by a collectively-negotiated agreement, if those employees provide or oversee programs or services utilized by sending district students.
- (9) Any matter concerning governance of the receiving district board of education, including, but not limited to, the selection of board president and vice-president, approval of board bylaws, and the employment of professionals or consultants such as attorneys, architects, engineers, or others who provide services to the receiving district board of education.

To the extent the Jamesburg Representative inadvertently votes on any other matter, his vote shall not be counted.

Note 3: Public discussion is confined to this portion of the Agenda unless permission is granted by the Board President prior to the start of the meeting or when the Board is considering a Special Agenda Item that the Board deems appropriate for public participation. Anyone wishing to address the Board is requested to stand and state his/her name and address.
