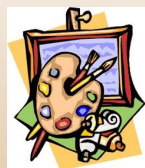
The above students have met the following Criteria:

Congratulations to the Girls Bowling Team for winning their first ever GMC County Championship and finishing with an undefeated 14-0 season. They became the Red Division Champions!



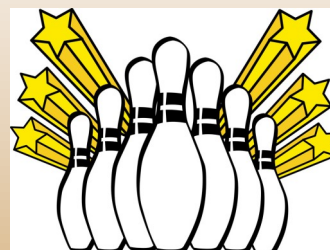

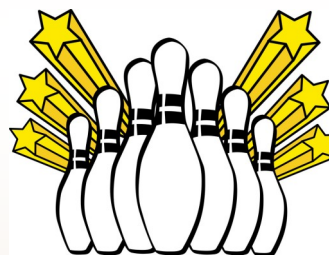


BOWLING cont.

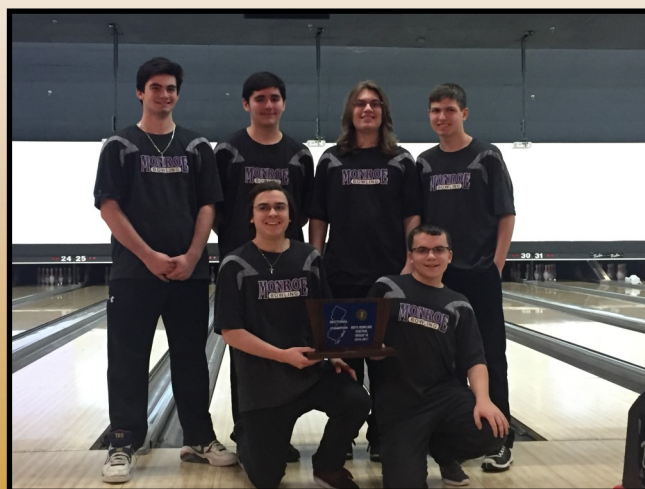
