## MTHS VEX Robotics Competition Feb 11, 2023



The MTHS Robotics Club successfully hosted its annual VEX Robotics Competition (VRC) Spin Up on Feb 11, 2023 at the high school. 36 teams from across the state participated in this day long event and competed for the tournament and skills champion positions.

A lot of preparation goes into hosting an event of this magnitude by the planning committee led by seniors at the high school. The entire team of MTHS Robotics Club and myself are grateful to the administrators, athletic department, teachers (video production, chorus, graphic design, industrial arts), cafeteria personnel, janitors, security personnel, transportation department and general members from the club for constantly supporting us and cheering for us too. We also want to express our gratitude to the community of local university and high schools that helped with running / judging at the event and sharing the field and field elements with us – Rutgers's University, Colts Neck High and Cherry Hill High School.

Both of our teams made it to the State Championship to be held on March 4th in Bell Works Holmdel, NJ.
